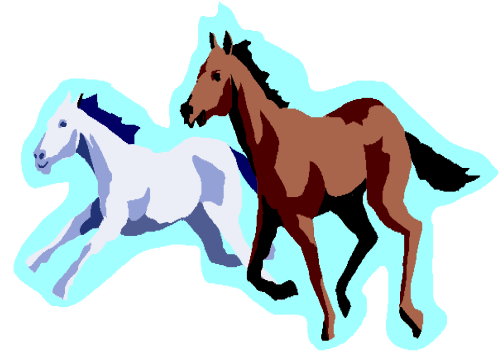

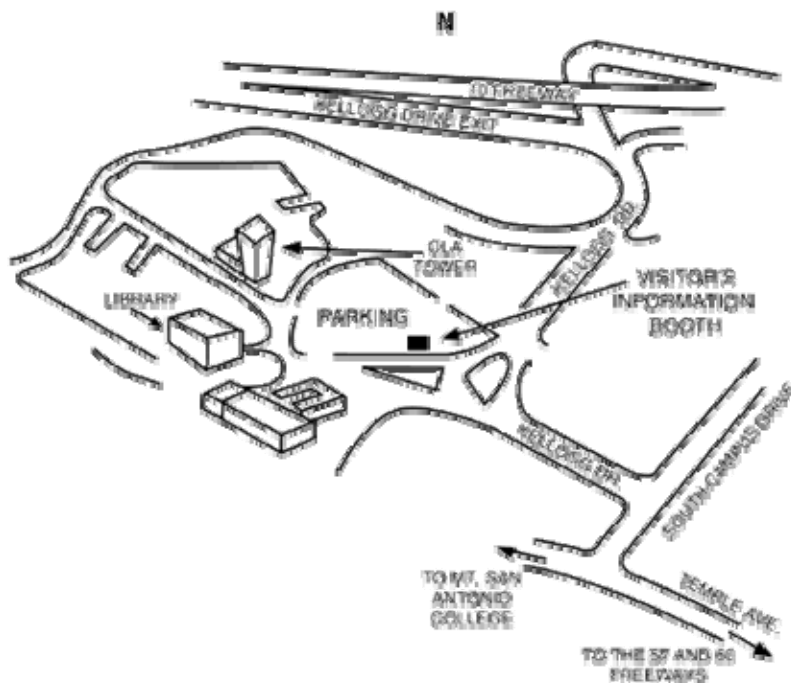

Driving Directions to Cal Poly Pomona



W.K. KELLOGG ARABIAN HORSE is located off on Kellogg Drive on Eucalyptus Lane. Look for 29 & 67 on the campus map on the web site. On this map, it is located where the words "Visitor Information Booth" are printed.

From Los Angeles:

Take the 10 freeway EAST and exit at Kellogg Drive.

From Orange County:

Take the 57 freeway NORTH to Temple Avenue and exit north (left-hand turn) to the campus.

From The Inland Empire:

Take the 10 freeway WEST and exit at Kellogg Drive.

From the Pasadena area:

Take the 210 freeway EAST to 57 Freeway SOUTH. Exit on Temple Avenue and turn north (right-hand turn) to the campus.

REDDING – 570 miles/8 hours 29 minutes
YREKA – 667 miles/9 hours 55 minutes
