



Junk Your Juniper!

Remove highly flammable juniper shrubs to help make your Tahoe landscape more fire safe!

Receive a voucher for a FREE replacement plant!

The leaves and stems of juniper shrubs contain a high amount of flammable resins, which adds "fuel load" to your home landscape. By removing and replacing your juniper shrubs with a less flammable plant, you will reduce the fire fuels around your home and throughout your defensible space area.

A photo of the juniper shrub that has been removed/pulled out of the ground at your residence is required for verification to receive your voucher for a FREE replacement plant.
