Some of the Newcomers for this year...

Abraham Lincoln

A big red heirloom tomato that is full flavored, of great appearance, and pest and disease resistant. Produces meaty, 8 oz fruit late in the summer in clusters of 4-6. The surface is smooth and seldom cracks.



Ace (hybrid)

Best for fresh use, the medium late, red, firm, oblate fruit are moderately smooth. The plants are medium to large and weigh 6-8 oz.

Amana Orange

A large orange heirloom tomato that takes its name from Iowa's Amana Colonies, where it has been a long-time favorite. With a mild, sweet, tropical flavor, this beefsteak variety's fruits are light orange and fluted, growing up to 1-2 lb. on indeterminate vines.



Arkansas Traveler

This 100-year-old heirloom favorite produces goodly numbers of rich flavorful tomatoes.



Deep pink when ripe, the round 6-8 oz. fruits' artful balance of sweetness and tartness accounts for its standing as one of the very best heirloom varieties. Disease-resistant, indeterminate vines.

Costoluto Genovese

A heat-loving, Italian heirloom tomato that has been enjoyed for many generations along the Mediterranean. Large, deep-red fruits have a singularly fluted profile, are deeply ridged, and heavily lobed. Meaty, full-flavored, slightly tart, and delicious. Because of its scalloped edges, perfect for use in an arrangement of different colored sliced tomatoes. Costoluto Genovese has been favored by generations of chefs in Italy and America for its rich flavors for wonderful pungent pasta sauce.
