The selected applicant will work along side the UC Livestock and Natural Resources advisor, Josh Davy at the UC Cooperative Extension office in Tehama County, weekly for 2 Summer months as a volunteer Intern. A \$1000.00 scholarship will be awarded to the selected applicant, the first \$500.00 will be given at the beginning of the Summer Internship and the 2nd \$500.00 awarded at the conclusion of the completed Internship.

General Information

This is a volunteer part time (2 days per week) internship position, with a flexible weekly work schedule, with a 2 month flexible duration between late May to August.
