<b>BIG BEEF</b> 	70 Days Indeterminate - Large Red Hybrid	These firm, crack-resistant tomatoes have a wonderfully sweet, slightly acidic flavor. Large 4 to 6-inch globe-shaped tomatoes ripen earlier than most varieties of this size, and they continue to produce throughout the growing season. Vines are vigorous. Tomatoes store well.
<b>CARMELLO</b> 	75 Days Indeterminate Red Heirloom	The Carmello is the number one market tomato in Europe because of its good sugar/acid balance, exceptionally fine flavor, and crack resistant skin. 10-12 oz fruit, good for slicing or cooking, or as an integral part of any dish. This hard-to-find tomato is disease resistant and easy to grow.
<b>CELEBRITY</b> 	70 Days Determinant - Medium Red Hybrid	Vigorous, disease resistant, high yield and exceptionally flavorful fruit make Celebrity a winner for gardeners. Great flavor in firm, 7-8 oz. crack-free fruits. Perfect for salads. Performs well in almost every region and under adverse conditions. Good blight tolerance and foliage cover. 1984 All America Selection winner.
<b>CHEROKEE PURPLE</b> 	80 Days Indeterminate Rose/Purple Heirloom	Plant produces high yields of 6-12 oz. purplish pink, slightly flattened tomatoes with green shoulders. Cherokee Purple tomatoes have a sweet rich flavor and are good for slicing. Grown over 100 years by the Cherokee Indians.
<b>CHIANTI ROSE</b> 	80 Days Indeterminate Pink Heirloom	Hearty and delicious, this rosy-pink beefsteak is thin-skinned with a succulent, balanced, complex flavor that does not disappoint. Heavy crops of 1 to 2-pound tomatoes grow on indeterminate, potato-leafed plants. Earlier than most other large-fruited heirloom tomatoes.
<b>CHOCOLATE CHERRY</b> 	70 Days Indeterminate - Cherry Maroon Hybrid	This chocolate cherry is the color of port wine and chestnut, producing an abundance of 1-inch round fruit in clusters of eight. Flavorful tomatoes are crack resistant and hold well on the plant. They can be picked several days before maturity and allowed to ripen off the vine without sacrificing quality. A good choice for gourmet dishes and vegetable platters.

<p><b>EARLY GIRL</b></p> 	<p>60 Days – <i>Dry Farm</i>  Indeterminate - Medium  Red  Hybrid</p> 	<p>Our earliest slicing tomato, Early Girl is a tomato that gardeners have relied on for many years. These smooth red-skinned, meaty 4-6 oz fruits are ready in just 60 days. Plants are disease resistant, heavy bearing and vigorous.</p>
<p><b>ENCHANTMENT</b></p> 	<p>70 Days  Indeterminate - Plum  Shape  Red  Hybrid</p>	<p>Great fresh in salads and meaty enough for use in cooking sauces. 4 oz - excellent for drying. Indeterminate so will produce all season long – disease resistant.</p>
<p><b>GREEN ZEBRA</b></p> 	<p>75 Days  Indeterminate  Gold/Green Stripe  Heirloom</p> 	<p>The 2-inch round, 3 oz. fruit ripens to a yellow-gold with dark-green zebra-like stripes. The flesh is lime- emerald in color and has an invigorating lemon-lime flavor. A great green tomato for brightening up salads and other tomato dishes. This exquisite green tomato was chosen by Alice Waters for her <i>Chez Panisse</i> restaurant in Berkeley.</p>
<p><b>JAPANESE BLACK TRIFELE</b></p> 	<p>75 Days  Indeterminate - Pear  Shaped  Black  Heirloom</p> 	<p>Pear-shaped fruit has green-streaked shoulders, deepening to a nearly black base—one of the darkest varieties of tomato available. The meaty interior has similar, opulent shades and an incomparable, complex, rich flavor to match. The fruit reaches 2 ½ to 3-inch long, 6 oz., and is very crack-resistant. Despite the name, this tomato originated in Russia. Potato-leafed plants.</p>
<p><b>JUBILEE</b></p> 	<p>75 days  Indeterminate  Orange  Heirloom</p>	<p>A very popular orange variety; fine, sweet, mild flavor; good size and yield. An old standard. Jubilee bears large tomatoes with very meaty, thick-walled interiors and mild flavor. The globe-shaped, golden-orange fruit is meaty, has thick walls and few seeds. High yielding. The indeterminate vines benefit from strong staking or caging</p>
<p><b>MOSKVICH</b></p> 	<p>60 Days  Semi-determinate  Red  Heirloom</p> 	<p>One of the most appealing extra-early tomatoes. Fruits are early, deep red, and cold tolerant. Rich flavor. Smooth and globe-shaped, 4-6 oz. with a small stem scar. Highly resistant to cracking, making it a perfect pick for the greenhouse.</p>

<p><b>NEW BIG DWARF</b></p> 	<p>75 Days            Determinant - Compact            Red            Heirloom</p> 	<p>This variety is wonderful in the garden and also in containers since the plant stays small (growing to about 2 feet in height) while delivering large, delicious tomatoes. Fruit grow up to one pound, more typically 8-12 oz. Fruit is deep pink to red in color.</p>
<p><b>OAXACAN JEWEL</b></p> 	<p>80 Days            Indeterminate            Yellow/Red Streaks            Heirloom</p>	<p>This beautiful tomato bears fruit that is golden yellow with ruby streaking, earning this variety its name. Fruit varies in size from 6 oz.-1 pound, and is beautiful whole or when sliced to reveal the brilliant red marbling within. The rich, fruity taste is refreshing and melon-like.</p>
<p><b>PORK CHOP</b></p> 	<p>80 Days            Indeterminate            Yellow            Heirloom</p>	<p>Pork Chop is a mild-tasting sweet tomato with outstanding flavor. Medium 6-10 oz. beefsteak fruit are yellow with green stripes, turning golden at maturity. Reliable production. Fresh taste; good for salads and slicing.</p>
<p><b>SUN GOLD</b></p> 	<p>60 Days            Indeterminate - Cherry            Gold            Hybrid</p> 	<p>One of the best varieties of cherry tomatoes, Sun Gold ripens to produce heavy yields of golden cherry tomatoes with a very sweet flavor. This tomato is popular in all climates as it produces in both warm and cold conditions. Fruit matures quickly and is plentiful. This is one of the sweetest tasting cherry tomatoes on the market!</p>
<p><b>SWEET 100</b></p> 	<p>65 Days            Indeterminate - Cherry            Red            Hybrid</p> 	<p>Bursting with sugary flavor, Sweet 100's produce bright red, cherry- sized fruits in long clusters from maturity right up to the first frost. These vigorous climbers need staking to keep the fruit off the ground and avoid pests. Plant in direct sun (6 or more hours each day) and you will be rewarded with an abundance of flavorful, disease resistant tomatoes throughout the long growing season.</p>

**Selection Tip:** when choosing varieties, keep in mind that "Determinant" tomatoes ripen over 3-4 weeks on bushy vines that usually need no staking. "Indeterminate" vines continue to grow and produce fruit all season until frost. Large Indeterminate vines need support.
