

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS
OF THE
WOLF CREEK 4-H CLUB

Article I

Name: The name of this club shall be the wolf creek 4-H club.

Article II

Purpose: The purpose of this 4-H club is to aid in the development of its members through project work, club meetings, demonstrations, judging, community service, club and county events and other activities.

Article III

Membership: Any boy or girl who is nine by January 1, and not nineteen before January 1, of the current year shall be eligible for membership upon agreement to follow the requirements of 4-H club membership.

Article IV

Officers: The officers of this club shall be president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and reporter.

Article V

Meetings: There shall be at least eight meetings of the club each year.

BY-LAWS

Article I

Election and qualifications of officers: The officers shall be elected by ballot at the November meetings each year. A nominee for the office of president and vice-president shall have completed two or more projects. A nominee for the office of secretary, treasurer shall have completed one or more projects and reached his 10th Birthday.

Article II

Duties of officers: The president shall preside at all meetings of the club and have in mind at all times the best interest of the club. He may call special meetings with the consent of the community leader(s). The vice-president shall perform all duties of the president in the absence of the president. He shall serve as chairman of the yearly program committee. The secretary shall keep a record of all proceedings of the club, shall act as club correspondent, in matters pertaining to the business of the club, and shall keep an accurate enrollment of club members. The treasurer shall receive and keep all money belonging to the club and shall pay it out only upon order of the president, after club action. He shall keep an accurate record of all money received and paid out. And keep a report up-to-date in the secretary's book. The reporter shall write a news report of the club meetings and club activities for the local newspaper.

Article III

Committees: committees, standing and special, will be appointed by the president.

Article IV

Meetings: the regular meeting of the club shall take place on the second Monday of each month. Special meetings may be called by the president with the consent of the community club leader.

Article V

Quorum:

A quorum shall consist of a majority of the membership.

Article VI

Program of Work: A written plan of work shall be adopted not later than the third meeting of the club year.

Article VII

Amendments:

These by-laws may be amended by a majority vote of the members present at any regular meeting.
