UC Cooperative Extension – Central Sierra (UCCE) partners with local schools in El Dorado County to teach gardening, nutrition, and food system education. Our FoodCorp service member also works to assist schools to increase local/regional foods utilized in food service programs.

UCCE is seeking a FoodCorps service member with the following qualifications:

- Teaching and community development experience
- Must be able to relate well to youth, teachers, administrators, parents, and farmers.
- Possess some knowledge of gardening, agriculture and food systems.
- Must have excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Must be reliable, accountable, and a team player.
- Must have access to reliable transportation.

In exchange for your service, you'll receive:

- A \$17,500 living stipend paid out in biweekly increments over your 11-month term
- A \$5,730 AmeriCorps Segal education award upon successful completion of your term of service, which can be used for additional schooling or to pay off student loans
- Student loan deferral or forbearance upon approval from your lender
- Health insurance if you aren't already covered
- If you have children, you might be eligible for childcare reimbursements
- Numerous training and professional development opportunities
