About the Workshops: These workshops will assist producers in understanding available buy-up options and will provide an overview of the use of a web-based decision tool to determine NAP crop eligibility and estimate NAP fees, premiums, and payments. Producers now have the option to cover up to 65% of yield and 100% of the price compared to the old program where coverage was only available at 50% of yield and 55% of price.
