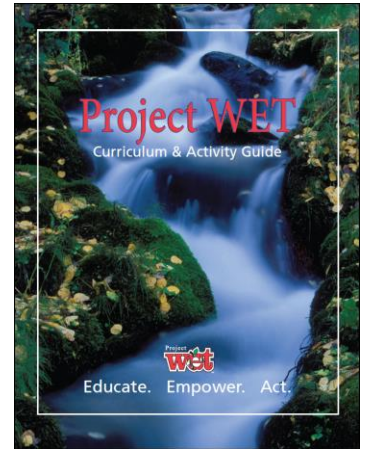


**SAVE THE DATE!**
