



## Monterey County 4-H Camp McCandless 2016 VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES

### TEEN COUNSELOR:

- Attend all monthly camp meetings, any planned cleaning or organizing days, and the full week of camp.
- Complete CPR training if you do not have a current card. Additional card cost will be paid by the Teen Counselor.
- Expected to participate in all pre planning meetings, other duties outlined and assist in fundraising activities.
- Complete all camp related duties in a positive manner and carry out all responsibilities as directed by camp committee members. Know and abide by the 4-H Code of Conduct.
- Be responsible for supervising and directing a small and/or a large group of youth in a positive manner.
- Work with all members, including other counselors, and serve as a visible role model in all your actions.
- Provide cabin decorations related to our camp theme to welcome your campers. Follow all instructions provided during your planning meetings.
- Pay the full camp fee (TBA at Feb. meeting) and CPR fee if you do not have a current card.

**SENIOR COUNSELOR (ages 18-24) & ADULT CHAPERONE (overnight, ages 25+)** *All adults must have completed an orientation with the County, be fingerprinted & cleared by the DOJ, enrolled in Monterey Co. 4-H as well as enrolled in camp.*

- Assist in the planning phase of camp by; attending the planning meetings from January through June, actively responding to emails and letters sent out by the camp committee, participating in camp related activities both prior to and during with our teen counselors and campers.
- You will be assigned to a "camp group" and a teen counselor to chaperone. You are to provide positive adult support and guidance while at camp.
- Be active in leading an arts & crafts project, sports activity or hike each day
- Work at assigned camp jobs.
- Pay a suggested Camp fee donation of \$50.

### Adult Day Volunteer (ages 18+):

- Assist in daily camp life by leading the daily activities or assisting in the specialized activities such as arts & crafts, sports, hiking and more.

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
