On the sample livestock application, you will see numbers 1 -14 throughout the paper. If you are interested in purchasing the insurance, please fill out as much as you can. We can help you with any other questions.

- 1) 4-H members name
- 2) 4-H members address
- 3) Name of 4-H club
- 4) This will be a 6 month policy. We will need the date you want coverage to start, and ending the Sunday of the fair.
- 5) Tattoo or Registration number (ear tag)
- 6) Kind of animal (swine) if you have more than one animal, put the 2nd animal on another line.
- 7) Breed (hamp/york cross)
- 8) Age (probably around 3 months)
- 9) Sex (barrow or gilt)
- 10) Weight (at time of purchase)
- 11) Current value (what you paid for the animal)
- 12) Amount of coverage you want to insure it for. (\$400, \$600, \$800, \$1,000)
- 13) Premium (Whatever the amount of coverage is, you will multiply that by 6%. \$600 value X 6% = \$36.00 premium. \$800 value X 6% = \$48.00)
- 14) If you have a loan to purchase the animal, you will write in this space the name of the lender.

I will take this information and enter it into my computer. Please sign the application at the bottom of the page. Please make your check payable to "Nationwide Mutual Insurance".

This is very cheap insurance to buy. If you don't buy it, you will wish you did...if your animal gets sick. Those of you who have 2 pigs might not need the insurance as much as someone who only has 1. BUT, it's still a good idea to protect your investment!!!
