

2018 4-H EXTRAVAGANZA STILL EXHIBIT ENTRY GUIDELINES

All entries must have been produced during this 4-H year

Entries limited to 5 per category!

**All Entered Items except for the cookies should be delivered to the 4-H Office by
Friday, April 6th 5pm.**

1. COOKIES (Limit 2 different types) Deliver by 11 am on April 14th Little Lake Grange

- a. Bring 2 dozen cookies per entry made from scratch, displayed nicely – they will be shared!
- b. A copy of your recipe must accompany the entry form
- c. Please make the cookies **SAMPLE SIZED** – or cut into small pieces.

2. EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY Posters or Tri-fold

- a. Posters minimum 14x22 inches and a maximum of 22x28 inches ready to hang or display
- b. Tri-fold display board not more than 36 inches tall. Not wider than 48 inches wide.
- c. Exhibits may show any topic of an educational or 4-H project nature
- d. Exhibitor's name should be put on the back of their entry
- e. Check your spelling, have a title for your project, have a 1-2 inch border, be able to read text from 10 feet away.
- f. Design is enhanced by one main idea, shows creativity and educational value. The entry should present a neat, simple and orderly appearance.
- g. Informational value is enhanced by: presenting accurate, timely, concise information by way of a clear brief message that is important and appropriate. Pictures and diagrams are great ways to convey your message.

3. FIBER ARTS – SPINNING AND FELTING indicate if needle felted or wet felted (if applies)

- a. All yarns to be submitted in one and one half yard skeins of at least 25 yards, no balls
- b. All yarns are to clearly indicate fiber content and intended use
- c. All yarns entries shall have a sample of original fiber in a zip lock bag attached to entry, so that the bag may be opened for examination

4. FINE ART PAINTING/DRAWING **Painting or Drawing please specify on entry**

- a. Entries may include painting on various surfaces or media, such as fabric, canvas, canvas board, wood, or glass.
- b. Entries may use oil, acrylics, water colors, etc. Please ask your 4-H office if you are in doubt.
- c. Entries should be ready for display. Ready to hang with fasteners and wire attached. No glass, please. Exhibits must be labeled with exhibitor's name, address and phone number on the back of exhibit.
- d. Maximum size 36"x30" including frame

5. FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS/SWAGS/WREATHS **Dried only specify on entry**

- a. Arrangement may use dried flowers and dried foliage.
- b. No silk, paper or plastic flowers allowed.
- c. Arrangement may not exceed 24" in width
- d. Wreaths must be ready to hang – please indicate if you are using a purchased or handmade wreath form and what material the form is made of

6. FLY TYING

- a. Entries will be judged on the quality of workmanship and the adherence to standard fly pattern descriptions.
- b. Entries can be made in each of the five Fly classes: Wet Flies, Dry Flies, Stone Flies, Terrestrial Flies, and Streamers.
- c. Specify pattern name on entry form.

7. FOOD PRESERVATION **Dried or Canned please specify on entry**

- a. Dried food items should be displayed on a dish or paper plate and be enclosed in a zip-lock or plastic bag. (Minimum of 4 items per entry.)
- b. All preserved entries in glass should be labeled. (One jar per entry.) with date and product name
- c. Include canning method used and processing time on a separate card

8. GLASS ETCHING/STAINED GLASS

All glass items must be framed or ready for display.

9. HOME ARTS/HOME FURNISHINGS

These items are specifically home decorations, such as painted dish ware, photo frames, dish towels, gadget holders, magnets, baskets, lamps, shades, pillows (not quilted).

10. JEWELRY

- a. Items may be made of beads, shells, feathers and hand formed beads.
- b. These entries also include cast and fabricated jewelry.

11. LEATHER CRAFT

- a. Items must be made primarily of leather.
- b. Items may include wearable leather, decorative pieces or utilitarian leather craft.

12. LOOM CRAFT **Beading or Weaving please specify on entry**

13. MISCELLANEOUS ARTS AND CRAFTS

- a. This is a catch-all for any entry that does not fit into or conform to any of the listed categories.
- b. Please name and label your entry accordingly. Call 4-H office with questions.

14. MISCELLANEOUS PROJECTS (No Arts and Crafts.)

Any projects that are not listed above. Examples of entries: Rocketry, Electricity, Computer, etc.

15. NEEDLECRAFT - CROCHET, KNIT **Crochet or Knit or Filled specify on entry**

- a. All types of fiber and fabric are allowed
- b. Wearable or decorative.
- c. Include care information either as a label sewn on the garment or on a separate card

16. PAINTING ON FABRIC ITEMS

- a. Entries may use sun printing, silk-screening, tye dye, transfer, etc.
- b. Pictures and wall hangings must be ready for hanging
- c. Entries should be ready for display.
- d. Maybe on accessories, canvas bag, apron etc.

- 17. PHOTOGRAPHY Color or Black & White** please describe on entry
- Entry consists of one individual photo, not a series of photos.
 - Photo size should be either 8x10, 8x12, 9x11 inch
 - All pictures must be matted on a standard 11x14 inch mat.
 - No frames or glass ready to hang with fasteners or wire attached.
 - Labeled with name, address and phone number and age on the back.
- 18. POTTERY/CERAMIC PAINTING Pottery or Green ware** please specify on entry
- The pottery/ceramic items need to be original pieces either hand formed or thrown on a potter's wheel. Any type of clay is acceptable.
 - The item may be green ware, painted and fired.
- 19. QUILTING Quilts or Wall hangings or Pillows or Tops** please specify on entry
- All size quilts or sampler quilts are accepted.
 - Quilt designs do not need to be original; old fashioned quilt patterns are acceptable.
 - Hanging sleeve needs to be attached
- 20. SCRAPBOOKING whole book or single page** (see below for limitations)
please specify on entry if whole book or single page
- Entries must be created during the current 4-H year.
 - Prepare a scrapbook using memorabilia as well as photographs
 - Black and white or color.
 - Minimum of 20 photographs in the scrapbook
 - Framed single page entry will only be considered for ribbon, not the county winner contest
- 21. WELDING AND FORGING**
- Member does not have to own the article, but must have made the entry.
 - Entries may be utilitarian and/or decorative. Examples of entries include: stools, steel post drivers, flower stands, door knockers, etc.
- 22. WOODWORKING Turned or Constructed** please specify on entry
Items must be made (turned or constructed) primarily of wood. These should be original items, not prefabricated from kits.
