

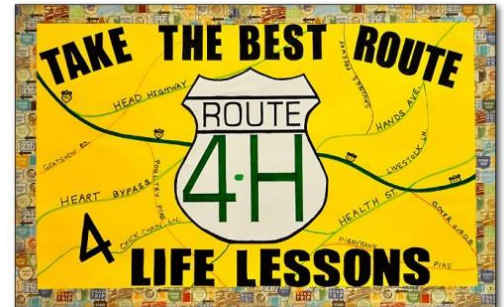

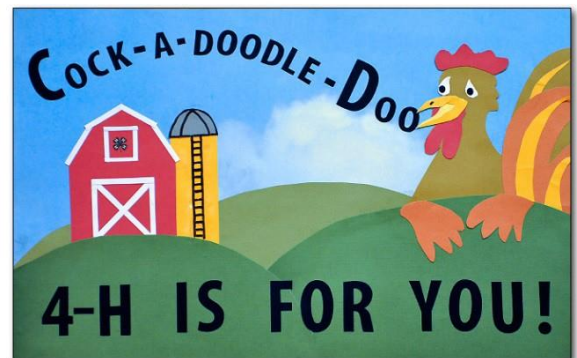

Each member may submit one (1) entry in the Mendocino County 4-H Poster Art Contest. Each club may submit one(1) group entry in the Mendocino County 4-H Poster Art Contest.

Entering Information for 2018 Poster Art Contest

Posters are due April 12th 5pm to the 4-H office in Ukiah or at Haywire in Fort Bragg

- a. Posters may be made by any 4-H'er or by a club or by a team of club members
- b. Posters may be horizontal only.
- c. Posters must be 14 X 22 inches.
- d. Name, address, county and age of the 4-H member(s) should be clearly written on the back of each poster.
- e. 4-H is to be the topic for the poster.
- f. Well known cartoon figures such as Peanuts, Sponge Bob, Charlie Brown, etc. cannot be used because they are copyrighted.
- g. Three dimensional objects or materials which extend 1/8 inch or more above the surface of the poster may not be used.
- h. If the 4-H Emblem is used on the poster, do not place text or other images over or on top of it. The 4-H Emblem should not appear screened under words or graphics. No photo, drawing, symbol, word or other figure or object maybe be placed on or obscure the 4-H Emblem.
