**Limit of 2 market goat entries and 3 breeding meat goat entries**

There will be NINE (9) County Winners recognized: Champion market (1), Champion breeder (1), club group (3), and each level of showmanship(3). \*\*The top two (2) of each class will go back in for Grand Champion. Up to six in each showmanship class may return for overall showmanship champion. (This will be left up to the judge's discretion) The winner of this class will compete in Round Robin.

**Division 8001** Market Goat (All goats must be dehorned, and if male, must be castrated)

**Division 8002** All Breeding Meat Doe – less than 1 year of age

**Division 8003** All Breeding Meat Doe – over 1 year of age

**Division 8050** Market Goat Pen of 3 (Club Group/ 1 entry per club)

**Division 8100** Novice Showmanship (Never shown Goats at Exhibit Day or Fair)

**Rules:**

**EXHIBIT DAY WORK DAY: ALL EXHIBIT DAY GOAT PARTICIPANTS MUST HELP SET UP PENS PRIOR**

Any animal showing signs of illness will not be allowed entry at time of check-in. **We recommend that goats come from CAE tested herds. if you do not know the status of your goats please segregate your animals from others.**

All Large Livestock are to be in their assigned areas by **6:30 a.m.** Please check in with your area supervisors. Listen to all announcements for instructions and changes. Judging will promptly start after the Dairy Goat Show. **Market classes will be broken down into groups according to weight.**

- Clipping of goats is not required.
- Feed, water buckets and any show equipment are to be supplied by exhibitors.
- Animals are not to be left unattended on grounds.

Be sure your club has a "designated supervisor".

PLEASE OBTAIN A RELEASE FROM THE AREA SUPERVISOR IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO LEAVE THE FAIRPARK AFTER EXHIBIT DAY.

**RELEASES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AFTER ROUND ROBIN AND AFTER FAIRPARK IS CLEAN**

(Approximately 2:30pm - no exceptions). Failure to do so will result in disqualification of the exhibitor!

**Accepted Show Attire for Exhibit Day:** You should wear white pants or dark jeans, belt and boots; and white long or short sleeved collared shirt. 4-H ties for boys and scarves for girl & 4-H hats if wearing 4-H whites. Extra credit will not be given or removed regarding wearing/ not wearing a 4-H uniform. Points will be deducted for nonprofessional show attire. Open toed shoes, shorts, bare mid-drifts, PJ's are not acceptable attire.
