Limit three for breeding and one for market

There will be EIGHT (8) County Winners

Division 9400 Feeder pigs - all breeds together

Division 9500 Breeding Hog

Division 9600 Group of three (more than one club entry is possible -TOTAL OF 3 AWARDS)

Showmanship

Division 9700 Novice Showmanship (never shown swine at Exhibit Day or Fair)

Division 9800 Intermediate Showmanship (have shown swine before)

Division 9900 Advanced Showmanship

Market classes will be broken into smaller groups according to weight.

- The top two (2) of each class will go back in for Grand Champion.
- Up to six in each showmanship class *may* return for overall showmanship champion.

(At the judge's discretion) The winner of this class will compete in Round - Robin.

Rules:

EXHIBIT DAY WORK DAY: ALL EXHIBIT DAY SWINE PARTICIPANTS MUST HELP SET UP PENS PRIOR

Any animal showing signs of illness will not be allowed entry at time of check-in.

All Large Livestock are to be in their assigned areas by **6:30 a.m.** Please check in with your area supervisors. Listen to all announcements for instructions and changes. Judging promptly starts after opening ceremonies. Feed, water buckets and any show equipment are to be supplied by exhibitors.

Animals are not to be left unattended on grounds.

Be sure your club has a "designated supervisor".

OBTAIN A RELEASE FROM THE AREA SUPERVISOR IN ORDER TO BE ABLE TO LEAVE THE FAIRPARK AFTER EXHIBIT DAY.

RELEASES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AFTER ROUND ROBIN AND AFTER FAIRPARK IS CLEAN

(Approximately 2:30pm - no exceptions). Failure to do so will result in disqualification of the exhibitor!

Accepted Show Attire for Exhibit Day: You should wear white pants or dark jeans, belt and boots; and white long or short sleeved collared shirt. 4-H ties for boys and scarves for girl & 4-H hats if wearing 4-H whites. Extra credit will not be given or removed regarding wearing/ not wearing a 4-H uniform. Points will not be deducted for nonprofessional show attire. Open toed shoes, shorts, bare mid-drifts, PJ's are not acceptable attire.
