Orange County 4-H Scholarship Application Form - Instructions

- ❖ Orange County Council and the Scholarship Selection Committee, in conjunction with 4-H YDP County Staff, are committed to awarding scholarships to candidates who go beyond the minimum participation in 4-H.
- ❖ Orange County Council and the Scholarship Selection Committee, in conjunction with 4-H YDP County Staff, are committed to spreading scholarship resources as widely and as fairly to as many candidates as possible.
- ❖ Awarding of a scholarship is intended to help support a 4-H member, knowing that the club or county also benefits when members achieve maximum participation in 4-H activities.
- ❖ Funds are limited, so scholarships are only available for 4-H sponsored events or projects.
- ❖ A member may apply for or be awarded up to two scholarships per year.
- ❖ Scholarships may cover all or part of the expense of participation.
- ❖ Members who fundraise to cover some of the costs of the event or project will be given priority.
- ❖ Members who are involved in club or county leadership will be given priority for leadership events, with the exclusion of Southern Youth Summit which is designed to encourage leadership discovery in youths ages 11-13.
- ❖ Incomplete or late applications will be disqualified.
- ❖ Application Deadlines and Selection Committee meetings for PY 2019-2020 are
 - Applications due: November 15 by 5PM; Selection Committee meets: November 26
 - Applications due: February 15 by 5 PM; Selection Committee meets: March 2

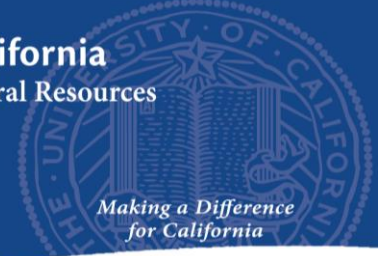
Instructions to Applicant:

1. Complete the application form. Be sure that all sections are complete and all signatures are collected.
2. Submit your application to the County Office by the deadlines established above - no late applications will be accepted. You may
 - a. email this application to rmjakel@ucanr.edu OR
 - b. you may mail it to: UCCE Orange County 4-H; 7601 Irvine Blvd., Irvine, CA 92618 OR
 - c. you may deliver it in person to the County Office
3. If you are awarded a scholarship you will be expected to:
 - a. Make a presentation at a County Council Meeting to share what you learned (including your fundraising efforts, if applicable) and to disseminate information to the other members and clubs
 - b. Prepare materials to share on OC 4-H social media
 - c. Volunteer for at least one 4-H event
 - d. Complete the attached GPS Reflection
 - e. Acknowledge the donors who made your scholarship possible (see Guidelines for Acknowledging Donors attached to this packet)
 - f. Encourage other youth members to apply for scholarships and attend events and assist them in completing applications

Guidelines for Acknowledging Donors

Donors are generous community members who want to support you as you learn and grow in 4-H. They have committed funds for specific purposes to be distributed to youth in need of support. Donors are civic-minded and want to know that their contributions have resulted in something good happening for youth like you. They deserve your gratitude and recognition. A personalized thank you note is the best way to do this.

Guidelines for acknowledging donors in writing:

1. Include your name and exactly what the scholarship you received was used for, including any registration fees or specific supplies or other needs.
2. Include a description of what you did or learned by putting your scholarship to use.
3. Include how this opportunity has impacted you and how it will make a difference in your future. Don't forget to include how you will use what you learned to make a difference in 4-H and/or your community.
4. Include a polite salutation at the beginning and a complimentary valediction at the closing of your note.
5. Use a thank you card, blank note card, personalized stationery, or a clean sheet of plain white paper. The note may be hand-written with excellent penmanship or typed.

Here is an example:

Dear Mr. Jones,

Thank you so much for the scholarship that your endowment fund provided. Because of the scholarship I was able to attend the State Leadership Conference. At this Conference I made so many new 4-H contacts and learned some amazing things about being a leader in my 4-H Club and in my community. I hope to share what I learned with the members of my club and next year to take a leadership position in Teen Council.
