THE FACTS

- You must pre-enter by completing the form below and returning it to the
- 4-H office by **April 17 at 4PM**.
- Your Mini Garden must be self-contained and measure **no larger than 21.5 inches** in diameter.
- Your Mini Garden must be delivered to Saralee’s barn at the fairgrounds on **Saturday, May 2, between 10AM and 12PM**.
- Attach a card with **Club/Project and Garden Name**. Be creative in naming your garden.

THE JUDGING

Gardens will be judged the morning of 4-H Open House and ribbons will identify the top three placing gardens. Judges will be looking for: Creativity, ability to follow directions, use of the **“There’s no place like 4-H”** theme, and how well your club’s garden promotes 4-H. Remember, the judge’s ruling will be final. Prizes will be awarded on stage at the ChickenQue.
