We had a potluck dinner social, made and filled many personal care kits as part of the State Fashion Revue Community Service, and discussed Fashion Revue information.

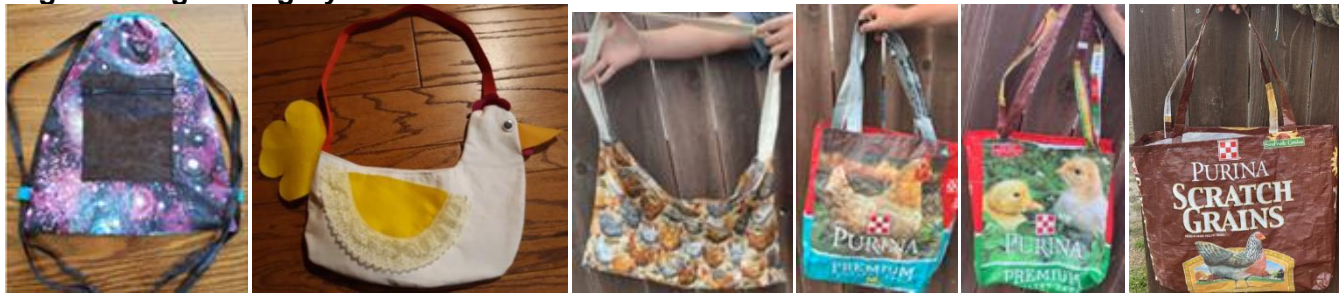
**2020 Sonoma County 4-H Fashion Revue participants and entries**
