

# CDFA State Water Efficiency and Enhancement Program (SWEEP)



## DESCRIPTION:

The State Water Efficiency & Enhancement Program (SWEEP) is a grant program that funds projects that reduce water use, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and improve irrigation efficiency. Components of funded projects include: Soil moisture sensors, weather stations, irrigation scheduling technology, evapotranspiration (ET) based irrigation scheduling, conversion to micro-irrigation or drip irrigation, pump conversion from diesel to electric or to renewable energy such as solar, conversion to low-pressure irrigation system, installation of a variable frequency drive (VFD's) and/or pump retrofit or replacement.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

- California farmers, ranchers and Federal and California Recognized Native American Indian Tribes are eligible to apply.

## AVAILABLE FUNDING:

- In past funding cycles, up to \$200,000 can be requested for this program. Prop. 4 was recently passed which allocated funds towards future SWEEP solicitations.
