



Glenn County 4-H Adult Volunteer Re-Appointment Process 2025-2026

As a volunteer, you will play an important role in the development of young people, helping them to identify their spark and develop the skills and positive outcomes that lead to thriving. Below are the steps to becoming a returning volunteer. We look forward to working with you as a valuable asset to the 4-H Youth Development Program. STEP #1

Submit the 4-H adult volunteer application packet to UCCE Office or process online enrollment at: <https://4h.zsuite.org/>. The ZSuite system recommends using Chrome or Firefox browsers. It is important for you to use your existing email. If you are having trouble logging in, please call the UCCE Office and we can provide a temporary password. Adult volunteer enrollment status will show as pending until all steps (enrollment, training, and approval) listed below are completed.

*Note: When enrolling under unit roles, please review the following:

Club Enrollment: Select Club

- Project Leader or Resource Leader- Other Volunteer
- When selecting project type, you can add project leader, assistant project leader, or resource leader.
- Key Leader of a Club- Primary Community Leader, Co-Community Leader, Assistant Community Leader

Attending 4-H Camp- Select Unit: Glenn County 4-H Camp

- Adult Volunteers at least 21 years of Age- Adult Chaperone
- Adult Volunteers Ages 18-29- Camp Staff

When entering your project, if you do not see it as an option, please call the UCCE Office at 530-865-1107. Be sure to complete all the waivers and self-disclosure, and press the red submit button at the bottom of the screen.

STEP #2

Complete required "2025-2026 4-H California Returning Volunteer Course" in Campus Extension*
