- How to produce new plants from parent plants using seeds, cuttings and division
- How to identify soil type and test soil pH and nutrient levels
- How to use different types of soil amendments
- How to compost with worms to produce nutrient-dense fertilizer

Plant propagation methods create more plants of the same species and is an inexpensive way to increase plant numbers and improve plant health. Soil testing and amendments optimize plant growth and help reduce plant diseases and pests.

Participants can optionally bring soil samples for testing (sample should fill a sandwich bag).
