





















rootstocks are currently being screened at both 90 and 250 days after inoculation with 150 live adult nematodes. We believe that 40 candidate rootstocks can be screened in 1989. Procedures are still being developed for screening *Prunus* accessions for resistance/tolerance to the ring nematode (*Crictonemella xenoplax*). Future releases of rootstock materials should possess resistance/tolerance to root-knot, lesion and ring nematodes.
