- Category for submission (only one submission per category, per county)
 - 1. Community service
 - 2. Demonstration garden
 - 3. Innovative project
 - 4. Research (applied scientific methodology)
 - 5. Special needs audience (e.g. senior, disabled or horticulture therapy)
 - 6. Workshop or presentation
 - 7. Youth
- Name of Project

- Budget Narrative (350 words max.)
