## Fresno County Pygmy Goat Show

When: September 26, 2020

Where: Mrs. Cehr's Residence (14747 E. Tulare, Sanger)

Judge: Ms. Debora Lyles

Due to social distancing and 4-H state rules limiting the number of 4-H members at an event, it is important that all times are followed. No one will be allowed on the premises until 5 minutes before their appointed time, and everyone must vacate the premise as soon as possible once the show is over. We must have the area vacated for the next group. Park on the street and wait in your car until 5 mins. before your showtime. Then walk in with your goat.

## Rules:

- 1. Entries should be emailed to aacehrs@gmail.com by September 18, 2020.
- 2. Each child may enter one goat. That goat will be used for showmanship and also shown in a breed class.
- 3. The cost of the show is \$2 per 4-H member showing (this fee covers showmanship and breed class).
- 4. Showmanship for each age group will be followed by a doe and also a wether breed class.
- 5. Grand and Reserve Champion Doe and Wether will be awarded for each age group.
- 6. **Juniors show at 9 a.m., Intermediates at 11 a.m., and Seniors at 1 p.m.** Please arrive no more than 5 minutes before your show, and leave immediately as soon as the show is over. The next group cannot enter the property until the previous group has vacated the property.
- 7. All 4-H State Corvid rules will be enforced during the show. (List of 4-H State Rules are attached)
  - A. Masks must be worn
  - B. Please maintain 6 feet distance between others (immediate family may gather together)
  - C. Each class will be a maximum of 8 members.
  - D. Parents must stay in the parent area outside the fenced-in yard. Two parents at a time will be allowed to take photos from the photo area.
  - E. Everyone in the fenced-in yard will be required to sign a COVID sign-in sheet.
- 8. Each exhibitor is allowed to have a maximum of three spectators with them, due to space and COVID-19.
- 9. Pygmy Goats will come to the show fitted and ready to be shown. One brush is allowed to clean off any travel dust from the pygmy goat before entering the ring. No other grooming or fitting is allowed on the premises.
- 10. A complete 4-H uniform is required to enter the show ring. Blue, black or white pants will be accepted.

## Guidelines

- 1. Bring chairs, snacks, and water. There will be no snack bar during the show.
- 2. Bring a water bucket for your pygmy goat and fill from the hose if needed.
- 3. No hay/alfalfa is allowed on site. Make sure your goat is fed prior to arrival.
- 4. Each family group is responsible for cleaning up after themselves.
