The Tulare County 4-H Youth Development Program (4-H YDP) is delivered by the Cooperative Extension through the University of California Agriculture and Natural Resources. 4-H is a community across the nation that provides experiences where young people learn by doing. Kids complete hands-on learning projects in areas like health, science, agriculture, and citizenship, in a positive environment where they receive guidance from adult mentors and are encouraged to take on proactive leadership roles.

4-H is available in Tulare County through after-school programs, community clubs, and 4-H camp. In 2016, the National 4-H Council and California 4-H kicked off the “Grow True Leaders” campaign. In Tulare County, we did just that; our Tulare County 4-H YDP enrollment grew 9% (849 youth members ages 5-19, and 276 adult volunteers) during the 2016-2017 4-H YDP year!
