# Tulare County 4-H Livestock (beef, sheep, or swine) Scholarship Guidelines

### **Purpose**

The Tulare County 4-H Livestock Scholarships are offered to encourage 4-H Beef, Sheep, and Swine project members to continue their education beyond the high school level.

### **Eligibility:**

- 1. Applicant must be a current high school senior, graduate, or equivalent who is already enrolled in **or** accepted to an institution of higher education. Institutions of higher education include accredited vocational schools, colleges, or universities.
- 2. Enrolled in the California 4-H Youth Development Program at the time of high school graduation or equivalent, such as receiving a General Education Diploma (GED).
- 3. Enrolled or planning to enroll in at least half of the full-time course load as defined by the applicant's institution.
- 4. Not older than 25 as of December 31st of the application year.
- 5. Applicants may apply for more than one species; separate application and essays are required for each species.
- 6. Recipient may receive the Tulare County 4-H Livestock (beef, sheep, or swine) Scholarship only one (1) time.

#### **Directions:**

- Complete the application and return it to the Tulare County 4-H Office by due date, same as record book due date.
- 2. Submit a copy of Academic Transcripts.
- 3. Submit Proof of Enrollment in or acceptance to an institution of higher education.
- Submit a 4-H Resume (Guidelines available at: http://4h.ucanr.edu/Resources/Member\_Resources/4-H\_Resumes/).
- 5. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation:
  - a. 4-H Adult Volunteer project leader
  - b. Professional reference outside of 4-H (community, work or school related)
- 7. Answer the following two (2) essays related to the intent of the award (500 words maximum per essay).
  - a. How has 4-H influenced your future plans? Elaborate on leadership and citizenship

- experiences as part of your overall 4-H experiences, including how those have helped the county and local 4-H Youth Development Programs and affected your career goals.
- b. How have you demonstrated a high level of skill and knowledge in the Livestock (beef, sheep, or swine) project? Elaborate on your involvement in the various levels of the project, including Junior and/or Teen Leadership, and include any demonstrations or presentations you have given.

#### **Award Information**

\$1,500 scholarship (maximum)

A maximum of three (3) \$500 scholarships per year; one (1) for each species: Beef, Sheep, and Swine

#### **Distribution of Award Monies**

Recipient of the Scholarship must (within 12 months of the date the scholarship was awarded) submit proof of enrollment and a thank you note to the Tulare County 4-H Office before a check will be issued.

#### **Distribution of Guidelines**

Guidelines shall be posted annually on the Tulare County 4-H website and sent to community club leaders, interested 4-H'ers, and members of the selection committee.

#### Review

Guidelines for the Tulare County 4-H Scholarship shall be reviewed and updated as necessary by the 4-H Staff, Incentives & Recognition Committee, and Leader's Council Executive Board.
