Dear Teachers, Guidance Counselors & Students:

The Tulare County Farm Bureau Scholarship program was organized to give scholarships annually based on academic achievement, leadership skills and need. Below are the requirements for applicants, and a listing of all the available awards. Note, not all awards may be given each year and are contingent upon available funding and applicant pool. Applications should be typed.

To be eligible:

- Must attend high school currently or have graduated from a high school in Tulare County
- Undergraduate and Graduate Students may be considered for awards
- Must complete and return application (PDF Form by email or paper version by mail)
- Must submit two letters of recommendation (from different individuals)
- Must submit a copy of current school transcript with application (prior to March 1) **
- Student must attend an in-person interview with the selection committee

IF ANY OF THE ABOVE ITEMS ARE MISSING FROM YOUR APPLICATION PACKET AFTER MARCH 1, YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

IT IS THE APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY TRANSCRIPTS HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED PRIOR TO MARCH 1 DEADLINE.

Awards are given primarily to agricultural majors, pursuing 2 or 4 year studies at major universities, trade schools, or community colleges. Awards are made by a Scholarship Committee of the Farm Bureau annually. Note: the Student of Farm Employee Awards, and the Sandi Gist Langiano Memorial have their own specific (non ag major) criteria.

Scholarships directed to Agriculture majors:

Scholarships directed to other majors:

- Student of Farm Employee award is only for children of farm employees
- Sandi Gist Langiano Memorial award is for a teacher candidate in a credential program

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

DO YOU HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF A COUNTY FARM BUREAU? No, but you must be currently attending or have graduated from a school in Tulare County.

WHAT CRITERIA ARE USED TO SELECT WINNERS? Awards are made based on scholastic achievement, career goals, leadership skills, and financial need. Top applicants will be interviewed after the March 1 deadline.

WHEN IS THE DEADLINE? All information requested on the application must be postmarked on or before March 1. We will not consider documents submitted after this date. You will be notified by mail of the selection committee's results by May 1.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS RENEWABLE? Only the Shannon Memorial award is renewable. A current college registration form verifying 12 units or more and previous quarter/semester grades with a GPA of 2.8 or better will be required for renewal consideration. The Tulare County Farm Bureau office must receive this information and a letter requesting consideration for renewal no later than September 15 to receive a renewable award.

WILL AN UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT BE ACCEPTED? A transcript from the school registrar's office will be accepted, both official and unofficial, as long as it is issued by the registrar's office. A "screen print" from an internet page displaying grades will not be accepted.

INSTRUCTIONS

Scholarship application and all required material pertaining to it must be sent to **Tulare County Farm Bureau Scholarship Fund**, **737 N. Ben Maddox Way**, **Visalia**, **CA 93292 postmarked by March 1st**. Applications and/or accompanying documents postmarked after March 1st will not be considered. All material provided must be on 8 1/2" x 11" paper and current application must be used or will not be accepted. The two letters of recommendation must contain the following: The name of the applicant, comments on the applicant's character and abilities and an opinion of his/her ability to profit from a college education. (A parent or close relative cannot be considered as a reference). The name and occupation of each person writing a letter of recommendation is required. Each letter must be signed. Letters of recommendation must also be postmarked by March 1st.
