Record Book Workshop

On May 15th at 6 p.m. in the Large Conference Room of the U.C. Extension Office Program Representative, Vera M. Allen will be holding a Record Book workshop. This workshop is designed to introduce those who have not had experience with records books to them and will also help those who have to improve their record books.

The 4-H program has a long history of record keeping. The focus reflects the importance of this life skill in our daily lives. In 4-H, young people have tracked their activities, events, profits and losses, skill development and learning experiences, and much more using the iconic 4-H Record Book. NEW Swine Pre-Weigh-In Protocol

Amador County Fair Board announces porcine epidemic diarrhea virus (PEDV) biosecurity measures for swine tagging on May 24, 2014 from 7am - 11am

All market swine exhibitors will be required to bring their project animals to the fairgrounds on May 24. 2014 between 7am -11am and will be ear tagged and photographed. To protect the hogs from exposure to PEDV all pigs will remain in their trailers and not weighed. Strict biosecurity protocols will be followed.

The rate of gain contest will be suspended for 2014 and any sponsored awards for the rate of gain contest will be distributed to other contests. Because the processor will not accept hogs over 270lb and are considered not market ready the 270lb weight limit on hogs at fair-time will be enforced and will not allowed to show and sell in the Junior Livestock Auction.

The Amador County Fair Board of Directors has been monitoring the porcine epidemic diarrhea virus (PEDV) outbreak closely since the disease was identified in the United States. After consulting with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) the Board has determined that while the disease is most severe in very young pigs and the disease has the potential to affect pigs of any age.

Details surrounding the outbreak are still unfolding. The disease is transferred via swine feces and survives in manure for extended periods of time.
