From Arkansas to
California by
covered wagon

'Cecile Brunner' 1894



Polyantha

aka "Sweetheart Rose"
Vigorous climber
Perfect miniature buds
Light pink,
Sweet and spicy scent
May not repeat bloom

'Climbing American Beauty' 1875



Hybrid Perpetual

Climber (rarely grown)
Globular, varying pinks
Repeat blooms - flushes
Caused a revolution in
the florist industry

"Gatewood Street San Andreas"



Wichurana

Small leaved,
sprawling shrub
Clusters of white
flowers
Repeat blooming

"Jackson Gate Neighbor"



Rambler
New photo next spring!
From an old, medium-sized
shrub
Pink, double blooms
Once bloomer

'Mutabilis' pre-1894



China
Rosa chinensis 'mutabilis'
Showy single blossoms
that change color from
yellow to pink to crimson
Flowers in flushes

"Jackson Gate Pink"



Hybrid Perpetual
Bushy shrub
Pink blooms in spring
Very hardy
Found abandoned near
old homestead

"North Bloomfield Raspberry"



Hybrid Setigera
North American native
Hardy and vigorous
Raspberry pink blend
Found rose in Northern
California mining town
Arching and late blooming

"Moss" in Moke Hill plot



Unknown Moss
Moss roses are a
mutation of
either Centifolia
or Damask roses
Once bloomer

"Old Red Runaround"



Gallica - China
Sprawling bush
Wine-colored blooms,
fully double
A true survivor, makes
a great hedge
Blooms once in spring

'Perle d'Or' 1883



Polyantha

Dwarf shrub

Spidery petals

Honey-pink

Blooms spring to fall

"Six Mile Road Gallica"



Gallica

Suckering shrub
from Murphys

Small, double,

lilac pink blooms

Once bloomer

Rosa californica



Wild

California native

vigorous shrub

clusters of mid-pink early
spring blossoms

long bloom season

little scent, showy hips

Rosa x odorata 1808



China

Large shrub

Pink blooms

in spring

Probably hybrid of

R. chinesis, Gallica

and Damask

"June's Pinky"

No photo at this time

Hybrid Tea about 1930.

Lovely pink from June Vaira's garden

Expected to repeat

Mystery rose

Possibly "ORR" or *R x odorata*

'BALLERINA' – 1937



Hybrid Musk

Large clusters of small, single, soft pink blooms with white eyes
Blooms in flushes all season
No particular scent
Rounded shrub – takes shade

"IRENE'S ROSE" – about 1930



Modern Pink

Hybrid tea?

Fragrance?

Clear pink

Blooms spring to summer

'BARONNE PREVOST' – 1842



not in the HRG yet

Large, deep rose pink
Hybrid perpetual
Old rose shape (quartered)
Repeat blooming
Tough, compact shrub
Fragrant

'Mr. Lincoln' – 1964



Hybrid Tea

Large flowered

Strong fragrance

Vigorous shrub

Likes Mediterranean climate

'CREPUSCULE' – 1904



not in HRG yet

Old Noisette, climber
Apricot blend
Blooms spring to fall
Likes sun or shade
