FAQ's:

Why does it take so long to know the dates for Presentation Day and Fashion Revue?

Butte College does not let us book a date until late November/December. They give priority to their student organizations and stakeholders first, and we have to wait until after they finalize their Spring Calendar to pick our dates.

Why do we go to Butte College then?

Presentation Day requires so many rooms with A/V equipment that BC is one of the only locations able to accommodate us. Public schools the right to deny groups rental requests, and teachers don't like folks using their classrooms on weekends, so we haven't been able to secure one. Fashion Revue requires a stage with audio, a greenroom, and an extra room for judging, and the college has historically been the most cost effective and available venue.
