

San Diego County Director Search Q&A

Q: Will I need to live in San Diego County?

A: Not necessarily, but you will need to live within commuting distance. To be an effective County Director you will need visibility with UCCE staff/academics and the San Diego County administrators.

Q: Is this a new job or an add-on to my current job?

A: The county director role will be in addition to your current role. You will be compensated for the extra duties by receiving an \$8,000 annual stipend.

Q: What is the expected effort to be County Director?

A: San Diego is a large UCCE office. It is expected that you will need to put in 0.5FTE in effort.

Q: Who will supervise me as County Director?

A: The Vice Provost of Research and Extension, currently Mark Lagrimini.

Q: Will there be any financial assistance for relocating?

A: No. Relocation is voluntary and ANR will not provide assistance.
