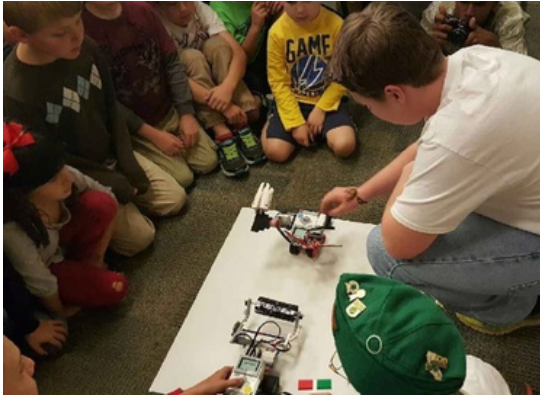

4-H fosters an innovative, “learn by doing” approach with proven results. The 4-H Study of Positive Youth Development shows that youth engaged with 4-H are:

- 1.9 times more likely to get better grades in school;
- 1.7 times more likely to plan to take courses or pursue a career in a science related field;
- 2 times more likely to have higher civic identity and engagement;
- 2 times more likely to report healthier living; and
- 3.4 times more likely to actively contribute to their communities.

Youth are eligible to participate in 4-H if they meet the following criteria:

**Primary Member** - Must be 5 years old by December 31 of the program year. Primary members cannot enroll in large animal or shooting sports projects.

**Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Members** - Must be 9 years old by December 31 of the program year and may continue in the program until the end of the calendar year in which they become 19 years of age.
