Accomplishments - 2008-09

- Reinstated County staff to 4 positions
 - Hired Staff Assistant (S. A.) I
 - Reclassified S. A. I to II
- County agreed to deliver cable TV to our conference rooms
 - Acquired two HD TV's for conference rooms - valued @ \$3,423
 - Annual value of cable ~ \$600
- County refurbishes attached storage building including permanent shelving
 - Valued @ \$5,500
- Budget remains intact with no major reductions
 - 2008-09 budget
 - \$270,828
 - County employees furloughed 1 day per month
 - 2009-10 budget
 - Increased \$42,910 (15.84%)
 - \$313,738
