DUTIES OF ELECTED OFFICERS

PRESIDENT: Presides over and conducts all regular and special meetings of the Calaveras 4-H Council; serves as an ex-officio member of all committees of the Calaveras 4-H Council; and appoints members of such committees; signs documents/correspondence when necessary; maintains order.

VICE PRESIDENT: Presides at all meetings of the Calaveras 4-H Council in the absence of the President; may serve as Chairman of the Program Committee and other important committees if so named by the President.

SECRETARY: Records the minutes of the meetings of the Council and carries on such correspondence as the Council and the president shall direct.

TREASURER: Receives deposits, disperses and keeps a complete and accurate accounting of all moneys received by the Council; signs Council issued checks; pays Council-related bills.

Calaveras 4-H Council meets most months, typically on the third Wednesday of the month. Meeting dates are always listed in the 4-H Clover Country Newsletter which is posted online.
