

Dr. Akif Eskalen is a Professor in Cooperative Extension in the Plant Pathology at UC Davis. Research in his lab is applied and focuses on the identification, biology, epidemiology, and management of fungal pathogens on the grapevine, trees fruits, and small fruits in California. His recent work established a linkage between agricultural and native tree pathogens in natural ecosystems.

Dr. Eskalen had the award of arboriculture research by the ISA in 2016 and an outstanding education material award with his book chapter in California Master Gardener Handbook in 2015. In addition, he served as the president of the American Phytopathological Society, Pacific Division, in 2020.
