

Chris Chen is the Integrated Vineyard Systems Advisor for UC Cooperative Extension and covers Sonoma, Mendocino, and Lake Counties. Chris received his Ph.D. from UC Davis in 2021 and has spent the past eight years studying vine responses to abiotic stressors like heat, drought, and salinity.
