



Proof of California Driver's License and Automotive Liability Insurance

UCCE SCC Composting Education Program Administrative Handbook, Appendix 7

If you will be driving as a part of your volunteer duties (those duties for which you receive volunteer hours) you must agree and certify that you hold a current valid California driver's license and maintain the required automotive liability insurance as explained below.

When driving as a volunteer for the UC Cooperative Extension (UCCE) Santa Clara County (SCC) Composting Education Program, (CEP) I hereby acknowledge that I hold a current and valid California driver's license and that I carry automotive liability insurance that meets the UC minimum requirement. I also certify that I will continue to maintain at least the UC minimum automotive liability insurance during my appointment as a UCCE SCCCEP volunteer.

UC policy requires employees or volunteers who are driving on UC business to maintain insurance coverage in the following amounts:

- \$50,000 for personal injury to, or death of, one person; \$100,000 for injury to, or death of, two or more persons in one accident; and \$50,000 for property damage.
- These limits are commonly referred to as: "50/100/50". These UC minimum insurance requirements are higher than the State minimum insurance requirements.

I understand that UC provides **secondary** liability coverage in the event of an accident during the course and scope of UCCE SCCCEP business and if my coverage is below the UC minimums, I am liable for the difference between my policy limits and UC's secondary coverage. _____(initial)
