Definitions:

Principal Investigator - the investigator primarily responsible for the design, conduct or reporting of sponsored research or educational activities conducted in whole or in part at the University.

Investigator - Any person, other than the principal investigator, who is responsible for the design, conduct, or reporting of the funded research project or educational activities conducted in whole or in part at the University (Form 800) at the time of proposal submission.
Significant financial interest—anything of significant monetary value, including but not limited to salary or other payments for services;

equity interests (e.g., stocks, stock options or other ownership interests); intellectual property rights (e.g., patents, copyrights and royalties from such rights); or holding a position as an officer, director, agent, or employee of a business entity. "Significant financial interest" includes such interests held by a Principal Investigator or other Investigators and by their spouses, domestic partners and/or dependent children.

For non-PHS funded Investigators, significant financial interest does **NOT** include:

- 1. Salary, royalties, or other remuneration from the University.
- 2. Income from seminars, lectures, or teaching engagements sponsored by public or nonprofit entities.
- 3. Income from service on advisory committees or review panels for public or nonprofit entities.
- 4. An equity interest in a public company that represents less than a 5% ownership interest and less than \$10,000 in value as determined through reference to public prices.
- 5. Annual salary, royalties or other payments from any source other than those referenced in subparagraphs (1) and (2) above that individually or when aggregated do not exceed \$10,000 over the next twelve months.
- 6. Income from mutual funds and/or pension funds;
- A percentage of income received from the Veteran's Administration Medical Center as part of physician reimbursement for University faculty;
- 8. Interest in a business entity if the business entity is an applicant for Phase I support under the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) Program.
- If a Positive Disclosure is identified, the Office of Contracts and Grants (OCG) staff will contact Investigators who have disclosed any Significant Financial Interests (SFI) to request the submission of the Supplemental Form. The Conflict of Interest (COI) Designated Official will review the Supplemental form to determine whether or not the disclosed SFI is related to the research project and may be moved forward for Conflict of Interest Committee review.
- The Conflict of Interest Committee will consider whether the Investigator's SFI could directly and significantly affect the design, conduct, or reporting of the applicable funded research project. Please allow sufficient time for Committee review.
- 3. All Principal Investigators and other Investigators involved in projects sponsored by the federal government must file an updated Form 800 and Supplemental Form (Statement of Economic Interests Related to Government Sponsored Programs and Other Projects Involving Human Subjects research) when they (or their spouses/domestic partners or dependent children) acquire a new financial interest related to a project, while the project is receiving financial support from federal government.

Records

The information provided herein may be released or transmitted to the sponsor, including Federal agency representatives, and according to the California Public Records Act, may also be released to the public, upon request. These records will be retained for 3 years after termination of sponsored project or until resolution of any action by the sponsor, whichever is greater. The Office of Record is the Office of Contracts and Grants.

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
