

## Stenciling Clean Up

---

### Paint

- Talk with paint supplier about proper disposal of used paint and paint cans.
  - Identify location(s) where paint can be dropped off for safe disposal
    - Household Hazardous Waste locations
    - Recycle locations
- Identify a washout area that can be used to dispose of water that is used to wash paintbrushes
- Identify a location to store extra paint once event is done

### Paint Supplies

- Have a buckets of clean water to rinse brushes and rollers in
- Have a trash box, can, or bag for used paint supplies (rollers, containers, paint cans, brushes)
  - Identify which supplies can be kept, and which ones can be tossed
  - Identify a location to store used paint supplies

### Cleaning Your Supplies

- Access to water is important. It would be ideal to have a hose or faucet available to wash supplies.
- Two, five gallon buckets are useful for washing supplies. Use one bucket to wash and the other to rinse. Buckets will need to be refilled multiple times throughout the day to ensure brushes and supplies are clean.
