<b>Angora Goats</b>	Learn about Angora goats and their care and management. Members may raise animals for marketing, breeding or for Angora wool. Ownership is preferable, but opportunities are available for non-owners.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Arts &amp; Crafts</b>	Various Art and craft projects including ceramics, jewelry, flower arranging, etc. depending on what the leader is inclined to teach.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Beginning 4-H</b>	This is a project for Primary members (5-8 years old). Several different projects are taught, mostly arts and crafts geared to the younger members of 4-H. It's a good introduction into the 4-H program.	<b>Primary Member (5-8 years old)</b>
<b>Birds - Poultry</b>	This project focuses on the care and showmanship of chickens and turkeys. Birds may be raised for pets, egg production, meat for home use or market, or for breeding and showing.	<b>All</b>
<b>Cake Decorating</b>	Members learn how to decorate a cake according to their tastes. Cakes may vary from advance to very basic.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Camping &amp; Outdoor Adventure</b>	Includes, but is not limited to, any of the following: camping, backpacking, fishing, hiking, mountaineering, first aid and outdoor cookery.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Cattle - Beef</b>	Training in the care and management of Beef cattle for breeding, show and sale. Member must raise their own steer.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Cattle - Dairy</b>	Learn about dairy cattle, their care and management. Members may raise animals for milk or breeding.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Cavies (Guinea Pigs)</b>	Learn about the care, feeding and management of cavies. Members may raise animals for pets, showing or breeding.	<b>All</b>
<b>Citizenship</b>	Learn about your rights and responsibilities, the common core values of the American democratic system, and how you can be a leader and make a difference in your community. Focus on personal development, history and culture, government studies and current issues.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Clothing &amp; Textiles</b>	The basics of sewing and mending are taught, and members will create fashion items. The care and selection of clothing is also explored. Projects can be shown at Home Ec Day and the Fair.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Crochet</b>	Crochet stitches are reviewed and members learn crocheting basics and complete crochet projects. Projects can be shown at Home Ec Day and the Fair.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Cross Stitch</b>	Techniques in the needlework and cross stitch techniques are taught. Projects can be shown at Home Ec Day and the Fair	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Dog Care &amp; Training</b>	Members bring their dogs to the fairgrounds for meetings where they are shown how to teach their dogs how to behave. Participants need to own a dog.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Equine - Horses &amp; Ponies</b>	There is one horse group in Del Norte County the Tsunami Riders. You will learn how to care for a horse, ride a horse and can learn how to work a horse through a series of obstacles. Ownership is preferable, but opportunities are available for non-owners.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Food - Cooking</b>	Members learn how to cook meals and safe food preparation. Basic nutrition is also reviewed.	<b>9 years and older</b>

<b>Food - Nutrition</b>	Foods project focused on nutrition.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Food - Preservation</b>	Safe food handling and canning is taught.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Fashion Revue</b>	Acquire knowledge and skills in planning, presenting and participating in fashion shows.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Goats - Dairy</b>	Learn about dairy goats and their care and management. Members may raise animals for market, milk or breeding.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Goats - Market</b>	Learn about meat goats and their care and management. Animals may be raised for meat, show, sale, or breeding. Showmanship is also reviewed.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Goats - Pack</b>	Goat project focused on the care and healthy maintenance of pack goats. Showmanship is also reviewed.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Goats - Pygmy</b>	Project that teaches the care and healthy maintenance of pygmy goats. Showmanship is also reviewed.	<b>All</b>
<b>GPS/GIS</b>	Learn how to use a GPS unit. Go geocaching and create your own treasure hunts	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Health &amp; Physical Fitness</b>	Those focus of this project is on personal health and well-being. Learn how to stay healthy by understanding basic health concepts. Participate in community health education and learn about rural health services extension and related public policy concepts.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Home Arts &amp; Furnishings</b>	This project embraces home arts, home furnishings and refinishing furniture. Color design, light, space and texture influence how we feel about where we live. Members will learn how to use these effectively to make living space more comfortable and attractive.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Leathercraft</b>	Learn to design, make and decorate leather furnishings and wardrobe items.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Marine Biology</b>	Learn about plant and animal life in the ocean, and about people's relationship to this resource.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Pets &amp; Other Small Animals</b>	Learn about, care for and train pets and small animals such as cats, hamsters, birds and white rats. May include breeding and selling.	<b>All</b>
<b>Photography</b>	Learn to use photographic equipment and take and/or develop photographs.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Quilting</b>	Members learn how to design and assemble a quilt using machine or hand methods. May include guidance in selecting fabrics and patterns.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Rabbits</b>	Learn the care, feeding, and management of rabbits. Members may raise animals for pets, fur, show or breeding.	<b>All</b>
<b>Robotics</b>	Members learn how to create robots using things found around the house.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Sheep</b>	Learn about the care and management of sheep. Members may raise animals for pets, show, wool, breed, or sale.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Shooting Sports</b>	Acquire knowledge of firearms and archery equipment, their operation, care and maintenance. Understanding hunting rules and regulations and practice them safely.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Swine</b>	Learn about the care and management of market swine. Members may raise animals for market or show.	<b>9 years and older</b>
<b>Veterinary Science</b>	Learn the range of behavior and characteristics of a normal animal. Learn about diseases, their causes and prevention, and precautions to control those diseases that can infect people.	<b>All</b>
