



## **California Fuchsia**

*Epilobium canum*, *E. septentrionale* (also known as *Zauschneria*)



Low growing perennial spreading by rhizomes to form attractive clumps of silver gray or gray green leaves.  
Produces clusters of brilliant red-orange flowers in late summer and fall.  
Winter Deciduous. Requires little maintenance; just cut back stems after blooming for new growth following spring.

**Other:** Does best with good drainage. Tolerates heat. Attracts hummingbirds and native bees.
