 - 40 weekly pantries
 - 50 meal and snack partners

Hunger in Marin



We collect millions of pounds of food from growers, packers, processors, manufacturers, the USDA and grocery stores



We truck donated food to our warehouse



Volunteers sort, repack, and shelf almost 350 tons of food at our warehouse every week



We deliver food to more than 400 community food partners



Visitors to our 230 neighborhood pantries select food at weekly farmer's market-style distributions
