

# BLACKIE'S PASTURE GARDEN PLANT LIST

March 2012

*Abelia* 'Edward Goucher' – Glossy Abelia – 3-5 ft. tall and wide. Small lilac pink flowers have orange throats.

*Acacia podalyrifolia* – Pearl Acacia – 10-20 ft. tall and wide. Weeping Australian native with yellow blooms February-March.

*Achillea millefolium rubra* – Red Yarrow - 1-2 ft. tall. Reddish pink variety, long lasting.

*Achillea millefolium lanulosa* – Mountain Yarrow – white blooms. Dense mat with flowers on 6-8" stalks. Butterfly attractant.

*Achillea* 'Moonshine' – 1-3 ft. tall and wide. Yellow blooms in summer to fall.

*Achillea millefolium* 'Terracotta' – 2-3 ft. tall, 5 ft. wide. Orange flowers become yellow as they mature.

*Agastache rupestris* – Hyssop, Licorice Mint – 2 ft. tall and wide. Multitude of apricot and pinky-purple spikes. Hummingbird attractant.

*Aloe* 'Johnson's Hybrid' – diminutive South African *Aloe* with bright green tapered leaves and orange pendulous flowers on erect, one-foot tall stems. Flowers April through November.

*Aloe reitzii* – 2-3 ft. tall and 3-4 ft. wide. Red flower spikes up to 3 feet tall with long, relatively broad silvery blue-green leaves. Summer flowering.

*Anagallis monellii* 'Blue Pimpernel' – 10 inches tall, 20 inches wide. Neat and compact with 1-inch bright gentian blue flowers. Self-sows when established.

*Anchusa azurea* 'Ankanet' – 4 ft. tall, 3 ft. wide. Bright blue flowers on branching stems. Deer and snail resistant.

*Arctostaphylos densiflora* 'Howard McMinn' – Manzanita 'Howard McMinn' – 7-10 ft. tall and wide. Small white flowers tinged with pink from late winter to early spring.

*Arctostaphylos* 'Emerald Carpet' – 'Emerald Carpet' Manzanita. 1 ft. tall, 6 ft. wide. Ground cover grows up to 2 ft. per year. Fresh green appearance year round.

*Buddleia* 'Lochinch' – Butterfly Bush – 5-8 ft. tall and wide. Light lavender blue flowers in late summer and fall.

*Bulbine frutescens* – Bulbine – 1 ft. tall, 2-3 ft. wide. Fleshy leaves with tubular yellow or orange flowers on long stems.

*Calamagrostis acutiflora* 'Karl Foerster' – Feather Reed Grass – 3-4 ft. tall with 6 ft. flower plumes.

*Calamintha nepetoides* – Calamint – 1.5 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide. White flowers turn blue as they mature. Blooms summer to fall.

*Caryopteris incana* – Common Bluebeard – 3-4 ft. tall, 5 ft. wide. Intense purple flowers.

*Chorizema* 'Bush flame' – Flame Pea – 2-3 ft. tall 3 ft. wide. Orange, red and pink blooms.

*Cistus ladanifer* – Crimson Spot Rockrose – 3-5 ft tall and wide. White flowers with dark red spots near stamens.

*Cistus x skanbergii* – Pink Rockrose – 2-3 ft. tall, 4-5 ft. wide. Pink blooms.

*Coleonema pulchrum*– Breath of Heaven – 5 ft. tall and wide. Tiny pink flowers.

*Coleonema pulchrum* 'Sunset Gold' – 2 ft. tall, 4-6 ft. wide. Chartreuse foliage, pale pink flowers.

*Convolvulus cneorum* – Bush Morning Glory – 2-4 ft. tall and wide. Blue flowers.

*Correa* 'Wyn's Wonder – Australian Fuchsia – 2-3 ft. tall, 3-5 ft. wide. Variegated leaves, red flowers. Blooms in fall and winter.

*Eriogonum arborescens* – Santa Cruz Island Buckwheat – 3-4 ft tall, 4-5 ft. wide. Pale pink to white flowers. Attracts butterflies.

*Eschscholzia californica* – California Poppy – 1 ft. tall, 1.5 ft. wide. Satiny orange flowers. Reseeds annually.

*Euphorbia characias wulfenii* – Mediterranean Spurge – 3 ft. tall and wide. Chartreuse to yellow flowers in spring. Gopher-proof.

*Euphorbia portlandica* 'Dolce Vita' – Portland Spurge – 1 ft. tall. Yellowish-green flowers from May to September.

*Euphorbia* 'Dean's Hybrid' – 1' tall, clumping. Bright gold-yellow flowers from June to August.

*Euryops* – Bush Daisy – 3' high and wide. Yellow flowers that bloom almost all year.

*Galvezia speciosa* – Island Bush Snapdragon – 3-4 ft. tall, 5-7 ft. wide. Red blooms. No summer water.

*Gaura lindheimeri* – Beeblossom - 3-4 ft. tall and wide. Pink blooms, flowers all summer.

*Geranium incanum* – Cranesbill – 6-10 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide. Purple blooms.

*Geranium* 'Rozanne' – Cranesbill - 1.5-2 ft. tall and wide. True blue blooms.

*Geum quellyon* 'Blazing Sunset' – 3 ft. tall and wide. Bright red flowers late spring through fall.

*Grevillea lanigera* 'Coastal Gem' – Woolly Grevillea – 1 ft. tall, 4-5 ft. wide. Red blooms in winter.

*Hesperaloe parviflora* – Red Yucca. 3-4 ft. tall and wide. 5 ft. flower stalks with red blooms .

*Iris x hollandica* – Dutch Iris. 1.5 ft. high. Bulb. Blue flowers with yellow centers late-March to early-April.

*Lavandula angustifolia* – English Lavender – 1.5 ft. tall and wide. Fragrant leaves and purple flowers. Attracts bees.

*Lavandula stoechas* – Spanish Lavender – 1.5-3 ft. tall and wide. Blooms spring through summer. Attracts bees.

*Lavatera* ‘Blue Lady’ – Tree mallow – 6ft. tall and wide. Flowering shrub.

*Leonotis leonurus* – Lion’s Tail – 3-6 ft. tall and 3.5 ft. wide. Tubular orange flowers in tiered whorls.

*Leptospermum* ‘Ruby Glow’ – Tea Tree – 6-8 ft. tall, 10 ft. wide. Shrub. Dark leaves, burgundy flowers.

*Leucadendron sessile* – Sun Conebush – 4.5 ft. tall and wide. Yellow bracts.

*Leucospermum* - Pincushion Protea – 1.5 ft. tall. Red blooms.

*Lychnis chalcedonica* ‘Maltese Cross’ – Lychnis – 2-3 ft. tall, 1 ft. wide. Red flowers.

*Lycianthes rantonnetii* – Blue Potato Bush – 5 ft. tall. Tree form. Purple flowers in summer to fall.

*Melianthus villosus minor* - Honey Bush – 6-10 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide. Showy gray-green foliage.

*Monardella villosa* - Coyote Mint – 1-2 ft. tall, 1-1.5ft. wide. Blue blooms.

*Nandina* ‘Firepower’ – Heavenly Bamboo – 2-3 ft. tall and wide. Bright red leaves in winter.

*Narcissus* – Daffodil – bulb – late-winter to spring flowering.

*Osteospermum* – African Daisy - 8-14 inches tall.. Spreading. Orange flowers.

*Penstemon gloxinoides* ‘Thorn’ - Beard Tongue – 3 ft. tall and wide. Pink and white blooms summer through fall.

*Penstemon heterophyllus* ‘Blue Springs’ – Foothill Penstemon – 1-1.5 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide. Low-growing plant with vivid blue blooms. No summer water.

*Phlomis fruticosa* – Jerusalem Sage – 4 ft. tall and wide. Tiered yellow flowers.

*Plumbago auriculata* – Cape Plumbago – 6 ft. tall, 8-10 ft. wide shrub. Light blue flowers summer through fall.

*Potentilla fruticosa* 'Goldfinger' 3-4 ft. tall and wide. Large yellow blooms, deciduous.

*Prostanthera ovalifolia* 'Variegata' - Variegated Mint Bush – 4-6 ft. tall, 3-5 ft. wide. Purple flowers in spring.

*Psoralea pinnata* - 'Kool-Aid Bush' – 12 ft. tall – fast grower. Clusters of lavender and white flowers.

*Punica granatum* 'Nana' – Dwarf Ornamental Pomegranate – 2-3 ft. tall, 4-5 ft. wide. Orange red single flowers. Deciduous.

*Romneya coulteri* – Matilija Poppy – 6-8 ft. tall. White flowers with yellow centers. Needs no summer water.

*Rosmarinus officinalis* 'Collingwood Ingram' – Rosemary – 1-2 ft. tall, 3-4 ft. wide. Aromatic with bright blue flowers

*Salvia argentea* - Silver Sage – 1-3 ft. tall and wide. Biennial. Silvery- white leaves, white-pink flowers second year.

*Salvia brandegeii* 'Pacific Blue' – Santa Rosa Island Sage – 4-6 ft. tall and wide. Whorls of light lavender blooms.

*Salvia chamaedryoides* – Germander Sage – 1-3 ft. tall and wide. Sage-green leaves and sky-blue flowers.

*Salvia coahuilensis* – Purple Jenny Sage – 2 ft. tall and wide. Long-flowering purple flowers.

*Salvia elegans* – Pineapple Sage – 3-4 ft. tall and wide. Bright red blooms in fall.

*Salvia gregii* 'Nuevo Leon' – Autumn Sage – 2 ft. tall and wide. Purple blooms from late summer to late fall.

*Salvia* 'Jean's Purple Passion' – 6 ft. tall and wide. Large purple flowers early summer through fall.

*Salvia muelleri* – Royal Purple Autumn Sage – 2 ft. tall. Dark purple flowers.

*Salvia* 'Shell Dancer' – Shell Dancer Sage. 1.5 ft. tall and 4' wide. Light salmon pink flowers.

*Spiraea douglasii* – Western Spiraea – 4-5' tall. Deciduous shrub. Dark pink blooms.

*Tecomaria capensis* – Cape Honeysuckle – 3-5 ft. spread to 6 ft. May be trained as vine. Orange red flowers from fall to spring.

*Teucrium betonicum* - Madeira Germander – 4' tall and wide. Violet spikes from May to July.

*Tulbaghia violacea* 'Silver Lace' – Variegated Society Garlic – 2 ft. clumps  
Violet blooms on tall stems.

*Verbascum olympicum* – Mullein - 8-10 ft. tall, 3' wide. Yellow-flowering spikes.

*Verbena lilacina* 'De La Mina' – Lilac Verbena – 3 ft tall and wide.  
Long-blooming purple flowers

*Westringia fruticosa* - Coast Rosemary – 4-6 ft. tall, 6-12 ft. wide.  
White blooms all year.

*Zantedeschia* 'Flame' – Dwarf Calla – 22" tall from bulb. Red/yellow orange bracts surround central spike.

*Zauschneria californica* – California Fuchsia – 6 inches to 4 ft. tall, 3-4 ft. wide depending on variety.
