<p>AUNT RUBY'S GERMAN GREEN</p> 	<p>75-85 Days Indeterminate Large (12-16 oz) Green Heirloom</p>	<p>One of the largest and most flavorful green beefsteaks with brilliant neon-green flesh. Fresh, sweet, rich taste and fruity flavor. Tastier than many red varieties, considered by many to be the best tasting green tomato. Easy to grow and disease resistant. Winner of the 2003 Heirloom Garden Show's taste test.</p>
<p>BIG BEEF</p> 	<p>70-80 Days Indeterminate Large (10-12 oz) Red Hybrid</p>	<p>These firm, crack-resistant tomatoes have a wonderfully fresh, rich taste. Large globe-shaped beefsteak tomatoes ripen earlier than most varieties of this size, and they continue to produce throughout the growing season. Vines are vigorous and disease resistant. Tomatoes store well.</p>
<p>CARMELLO</p> 	<p>75 Days Indeterminate Large (6-8 oz) Red <i>Container</i> <i>Heat Tolerant</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>The Carmello is the number one market tomato in Europe because of its good sugar/acid balance, excellent flavor, and crack resistant skin. Good for slicing or cooking, or as an integral part of any dish. This hard-to-find tomato is disease resistant, prolific, and easy to grow.</p>
<p>CELEBRITY</p> 	<p>70 Days Determinant Large (8-12 oz) Red <i>Container</i> <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Hybrid</p>	<p>Celebrity tomatoes are exceptionally flavorful, vigorous, and easy to grow--making them a favorite among gardeners. Fruit are firm and crack free; plants are disease resistant. Perfect for salads; use fresh. Performs well in almost every region and under adverse conditions. Good blight tolerance and foliage cover. Flatten globe shape. 1984 All America Selection winner.</p>

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<p>CHEROKEE PURPLE</p> 	<p>70-80 Days Indeterminate Large (6-12 oz) Rose/Purple Heirloom</p>	<p>Plant produces high yields of purplish pink, slightly flattened globe shaped tomatoes with green shoulders. Tomatoes have a sweet, rich and smoky flavor and are good for slicing. Use fresh. Grown over 100 years by the Cherokee Indians.</p>
<p>CHOCOLATE CHERRY</p> 	<p>70 Days Indeterminate Small (0.5 oz) Round Maroon cherry <i>Container</i> Hybrid</p>	<p>This chocolate cherry is the color of port wine, producing an abundance of small round fruit in clusters of eight. Rich, complex flavor. Crack resistant fruit. Can be picked several days before maturity and allowed to ripen off the vine without sacrificing quality. Good choice for gourmet dishes and vegetable platters.</p>
<p>EARLY GIRL</p> 	<p>55-60 Days Indeterminate Medium (4-6 oz) Red <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Hybrid</p>	<p>Our earliest slicing tomato, Early Girl is a tomato that gardeners have relied on for many years. These smooth red-skinned, meaty 4 to 6 oz fruits are ready in just 55-60 days. Plants are disease resistant, heavy-bearing and vigorous.</p>
<p>FLAMME</p> 	<p>75-80 Days Indeterminate Medium (2-4 oz) Orange <i>Container</i> <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>This beautiful and flavorful heirloom tomato originates in France. "<i>June Flamme</i>" ("Yellow Flame" in French) is a hearty blend of fruity, floral flavors, sweet and tart. Ample crops of orange-colored 2-4 oz. fruits are borne on elongated trusses. The fruit retains its deep orange color even when dried or roasted. Use fresh or in sauce. Similar to Sun Gold but with larger apricot-sized fruit.</p>

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<p>GREEN ZEBRA</p> 	<p>70-80 Days Indeterminate Medium (2-4 oz) Gold/Green <i>Container</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>This exquisite green tomato was chosen by Alice Waters for her Chez Panisse restaurant in Berkeley and is a favorite of chefs. The 2-inch round fruit ripens to a gold/green with dark-green zebra-like stripes. The flesh is lime-emerald in color and has an invigorating lemon-lime tangy, deeply sweet flavor. Great green tomato for brightening up salads. Use fresh.</p>
<p>MOSKVICH</p> 	<p>60-70 Days Semi-determinate Medium (4-6 oz) Red <i>Container</i> <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>High quality, early-season red heirloom that rivals hybrids. Smallish fruits are round to slightly flattened with deep red color and luscious, rich flavor. Abundant and crack-resistant. May be used fresh, dried, or roasted. Performs well in costal climates.</p>
<p>NEW BIG DWARF</p> 	<p>60 Days Determinate Large (8-12 oz) Red/pink <i>Container</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>This variety is wonderful in the garden, especially in containers since the plant stays small (growing to about 2 feet in height) while delivering large, delicious tomatoes. Fruit grow up to one pound, more typically 8 – 12 oz. Deep pink to red in color.</p>
<p>OAXACAN JEWEL</p> 	<p>80-85 Days Indeterminate Large (1-2 lbs) Yellow & Red <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>This beautiful tomato bears fruit that is golden yellow with ruby streaking, earning this variety its name. Large fruit, beautiful whole or when sliced to reveal the brilliant red marbling within. Rich, fruity taste, refreshing and melon-like.</p>

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<p>PAUL ROBESON</p> 	<p>65-75 Days Indeterminate Large (6-12 oz) Black-brick <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Heirloom</p>	<p>Popular among tomato connoisseurs because of its luscious, earthy, exotic flavors and good acid/sweet balance. Won “Best of Show” at the Carmel Tomato Fest. Called by some “the finest tomato in existence.” Named in honor of the famous opera singer star and equal rights advocate who stood up to the infamous McCarthy committee in the 1950's and had his career nearly destroyed as a result.</p>
<p>SAN MARZANO</p> 	<p>80-85 Days Indeterminate Medium (4 oz) Red Heirloom</p>	<p>This well known Italian heirloom tomato is highly prized as an exceptional sauce variety. San Marzano tomatoes have heavy walls and little juice and are generally thought to be more flavorful than the Roma. Elongated plum-type fruit is bright red, slim and 2-3 inches long. Productive over a long season.</p>
<p>SUN GOLD</p> 	<p>60 Days Indeterminate Small (0.35 oz) Gold Cherry <i>Container</i> <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Hybrid</p>	<p>One of the best varieties of cherry tomatoes, Sun Gold ripens to produce heavy yields of golden cherry tomatoes with a sweet fruity flavor. This tomato is popular in all climates as it produces well in both warm and cold conditions. Fruit matures quickly and is plentiful. Best fresh off the vine or in salads.</p>
<p>SWEET 100</p> 	<p>55-68 Days Indeterminate Small (0.4 oz) Red Cherry <i>Container</i> <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Hybrid</p>	<p>Bursting with sugary sweet flavor, Sweet 100s produce bright red, cherry-sized fruits in long clusters from maturity up to the first frost. Vigorous climbers, need to be staked to keep the fruit off the ground and avoid pests. Planted in direct sun, will yield an abundance of flavorful, disease resistant tomatoes throughout the long growing season.</p>

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THREE SISTERS 	75 Days Indeterminate Medium (4-6 oz) Red-pink <i>Cool Tolerant</i> Heirloom	The Three Sisters variety is so named because the plant grows tomatoes in three different shapes on one plant: a large round type, a plum tomato similar to a Roma, and a flattened globe type. Prolific and sweet. Excellent fresh in salads or cooked in sauces. Winner of the Marin Master Gardener Edibles Guild taste test.

Selection Tip: when choosing varieties, keep in mind that “Determinates” ripen over 3-4 weeks on bushy vines that usually need no staking. “Indeterminate” vines continue to grow and produce fruit all season until frost. Large Indeterminate vines need support.
