#### **Qualifications:**

- 1. Must be a Mariposa County 4-H Member graduating senior
- 2. Must have a 2.0 or above grade point average.
- 3. Must study in his/her chosen field at a college/university or vocational school of applicant's choice.
- 4. Must be currently enrolled in 4-H.
- 5. Attend 80% of current year club and project meetings at time of application.
- 6. Must have participated in Community Service, Leadership, or Citizenship (4-H, school, community or other).
- 7. Must have ongoing participation in 4-H fundraisers and 4-H events (county, regional, or state).

#### **Application Includes:**

- 1. Mariposa County 4-H YDP Scholarship Application.
- 2. A 3-5 page, typed, double-spaced essay written by the applicant addressing the following questions:

# What has 4-H YDP done for you and how has it prepared you for college and your future years as a responsible citizen?

- 3. List your most significant honors and recognitions received in 4-H.
- 4. Applicant must include 3 recommendations. Two of the recommendations must come from 4-H Volunteer Leaders unrelated to applicant. Others may be either teachers, counselors, or other persons within the community. Letters of recommendation MUST be included with application in a sealed envelope with reference person's name written across.
- 5. An official transcript of each high school attended mailed directly to the UCCE office must be received by April 5, 2024.

#### **Interview Process Includes:**

An interview tentatively on April 19, 2024 at the UCCE office beginning at 3:30p.m.

#### **Judging Criteria:**

The primary criteria for this scholarship are level, quality, and quantity of 4-H participation.

#### Selection Committee will consider the following:

#### Application, essay, and record book:

- Leadership and Citizenship exhibited both within the 4-H program and the community
- Achievements within 4-H and beyond
- Level of 4-H participation (project, club, county, region)
- Consistent dedication to activities while maintaining or progressing in personal development.

#### Interview:

- Ability to formulate a clear answer.
- Attitude (manner) towards questions asked.
- Self-confidence
- Neatness of appearance

#### When are Scholarships Awarded?

Mariposa County 4-H YDP Scholarships will be announced by May 3rd. The checks will be awarded to the recipients after receiving official verification of college/university or vocational school enrollment. Scholarships <u>will not</u> be held beyond one school year of the date awarded.

- Speak clearly, and at a normal speed. Introduce yourself and shake all the judges hands
- Be thorough and elaborate on your outstanding accomplishments
- Thank the judges for their consideration and time
- Remember, eye contact
