- Must enroll in a minimum of 12 college units.
- Must complete all application requirements.

For consideration, the following items must be completed and submitted:

Please submit originals, no photocopies.

___ **Cover letter**

This letter should be a short account highlighting your **4-H experiences**. Provide a one-to-two-page narrative on yourself. How has 4-H helped you prepare for college?

___ **Application**

Please submit current application. Be sure application is complete and neat.

___ **Transcripts**

Please submit official transcript that includes grades for the most recent semester (quarter).

___ **Three Letters of Recommendation (At Least Two must be from a 4-H Leader)**

- Submit letters of recommendation from three different individuals.
- Letters should be addressed to the *4-H Scholarship Committee*.
- Letters must be written no more than three months prior to the scholarship application due date.
- A total of three letters must be submitted (no more, no less).
