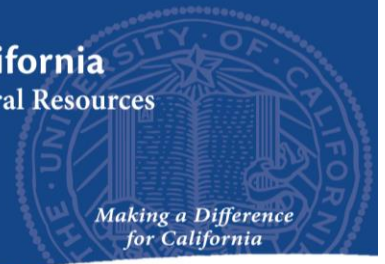

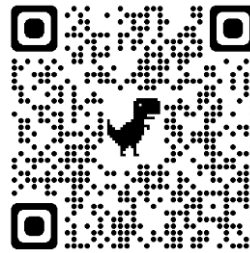

Napa County 2022-2023 4-H Youth Member Enrollment Process

Youth are eligible to participate in 4-H if they meet the following criteria:

- **Primary Member:** Must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2022. Youth who turn 9 on or after January 1, 2023 must participate as a primary member until the end of the program year.
- **Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Members:** Must be 9 years old on or before December 31, 2022. Youth may join if they are not 19 years old on or before December 31, 2022. Youth who turn 19 and who are already a 4-H member may continue capstone activities through December 31, 2023.

1. Find a local 4-H Club at <http://ucanr.edu/napa4hclubs>.

Contact the 4-H Club Leader before enrolling.

2. Submit 4-H youth member enrollment online at <https://v2.4honline.com/>.

- **New Member:** Create a family profile, create a new youth enrollment, enter all information, and submit. 4-H Online status will show as pending.
- **Returning Member:** Do not create a new duplicate account! Login to your family profile and click “Enroll for 2022-2023.” Enter all required information and submit. 4-H Online status will show as pending. To obtain a password, click on “I forgot my password” and then check your family email address for the temporary password.

3. Submit \$62 program enrollment fee to the UCCE Napa County 4-H Office.

- a. **Credit Card:** Pay online at <http://ucanr.edu/napaenrollmentfee>; service fee added.
- b. **Check or Cash:** Make payable to **UC Regents** and drop-off or mail to:
UCCE Napa 4-H, 1710 Soscol Avenue, Suite 4, Napa, CA 94559
(no service fee charged for checks or cash).
- c. **Request Fee Waiver:** The 4-H Youth Development Program is open to participants, regardless of their ability to pay. To request a waiver or reduction of program enrollment fees, please submit your request in writing to the 4-H office.

4. The application is reviewed by the 4-H Club Leader and the County 4-H Office. When approved, notification of your 4-H youth enrollment will be sent from 4-H Online.
