- University of California consists of 10 Campuses, 5 Health Systems, a National Laboratory and **Agriculture and Natural Resources**.
- University of California—Agricultural, Mining, and Mechanical Arts College"— is a **Land-Grant** University established by the **Morrill Act** of 1862. (1868 via Organic Act established our UC System)
- The **Hatch-Act** established the **AES** in 1887. (working title Ag Western Innovation Centers)
- **Smith-Lever Act** funds UCCE and **Statewide Programs** through NIFA (USDA) 1914.
- The California Constitution authorizes **The Regents** to receive and use the funds listed above.
- A Campus has a Chancellor, **ANR has a Vice-President** and the Labs have a Director.
- ANR’s Vice-President reports directly to the UC President
