Re: Systemwide Review of Proposed Presidential Policy Seismic Safety

Dear Colleagues:

Enclosed for systemwide review are proposed revisions to Presidential Policy Seismic Safety.

The current UC Seismic Safety Policy includes a deadline to bring all UC-owned and leased buildings into compliance by December 31, 2030. The Campuses have demonstrated that it is not practical to achieve full compliance by this date. Further, several Regents and Chancellors have expressed support to revise the deadline.

In response, in consultation with the University's Seismic Advisory Board, the Office of General Counsel, UC Health's Executive Leadership, Campus Architects and Directors, and the Vice Chancellors of Planning and Budget / Administration, we are proposing the following changes:

- 1. Replace the 2030 deadline with a continual improvement requirement for each location to achieve a minimum 4% per year reduction of non-compliant space above the established 2022 baseline square footage averaged over a three-year period. Note that any improvements completed in compliance with State-mandated requirements for critical care facilities will count towards the 4% reduction goal. Compliance will be evaluated over a multi-year time frame.
- 2. All currently-occupied facilities with a Seismic Performance Rating VI shall be prioritized in capital planning and funding allocation decisions and brought into compliance with policy no later than December 31, 2037.
- 3. Existing leases for certain non-compliant UC-occupied facilities may be extended through the end of 2037.

Initial feedback from those consulted has been positive. The continual improvement requirement continues the requirement to improve non-compliant space while providing a more feasible deadline to meet compliance. We will continue to advocate for State one-time funds to address our most-urgent needs.

Systemwide Review

Systemwide review is a public review distributed to the Chancellors, the Chair of the Academic Council, the Director of the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory, and the Vice President of Agriculture and Natural Resources requesting that they inform the general University community, especially affected employees, about policy proposals. Systemwide review for this policy also includes a 30-day Senate review.

Employees should be afforded the opportunity to review and comment on the draft policy. Attached is a Model Communication which may be used to inform non-exclusively represented employees about these proposals. The Labor Relations Office at the Office of the President is responsible for informing the bargaining units representing union membership about policy proposals.
