

Required Documentation for Applications

Applicants must upload the following materials to the application portal. All documents must be converted to PDF format (max 15MB). If you sign up for one-on-one technical assistance, please bring these materials to your appointment.

- ☐ Government-issued ID
- ☐ State or local business filing - articles of incorporation, certificate of organization, fictitious business name filing (DBA), professional license, government-issued business license or permit (i.e. Certified Producer Certificate - CPC)
 - This could be any official form showing business registration and business name with a preferred date backtracking to pre-January 1, 2020.
- ☐ Applicant certification form from Lendistry website, initialed and signed, agreeing to the eligibility criteria listed on the app.

- ☐ Online banking login information
 - OR bank account number and two most recent months of bank statements with transaction history
- ☐ Proof of employee count for 2022 via W3 document or payroll records or similar document, *not required for sole proprietorship*
- ☐ *For drought:* 2019 AND 2022 federal tax returns or IRS Form 990
- ☐ *For flood:* 2022 federal tax returns
- ☐ *For Non-Profits:* Proof of tax exemption

Growers will also need an email account and a phone number that can receive text messages for account authorization.
